



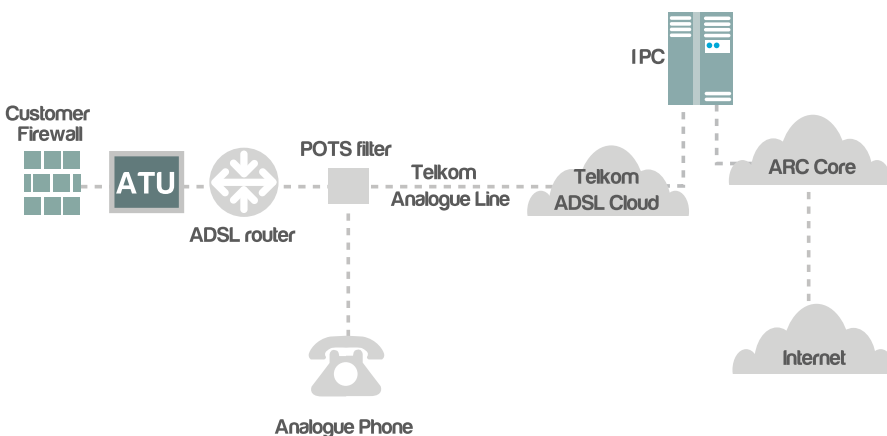

### Fixed Broadband: ADSL

Fixed broadband access uses ADSL (Asymmetric Digital Subscriber Line) technology to provide a high-speed, “always on” access solution that offers businesses fast and cost effective connectivity to the internet.

ARC has a direct link to the Telkom ADSL network via an IPC. This allows for increased control over the capacity utilisation resulting in a higher quality, business-grade ADSL connection with a lower contention ratio when compared to typical consumer ADSL offerings. ARC’s ADSL offering provides more throughput and therefore compares favourably to other ADSL offerings which can have customers contending with up to 250 other users for the same local and international bandwidth. By monitoring and controlling quality levels we can ensure an ADSL service that is not over-contended.
